PRAYING FOR THE NATION

HEALING AND UNITY

As the division in our nation becomes increasingly stark, let us begin by asking the Lord to bring healing and unity. The enemy thrives on division, and political differences often lead to bitterness and strife. Pray for a spirit of reconciliation to overcome division, and for believers to be examples of love and grace, even in disagreement, while standing firm in the truth.

"Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace."-Ephesians 4:3

Prayer

Father, we come before you on behalf of our nation, asking for healing where there is division. We ask that you would break down the walls of hostility and help us to be peacemakers. Grant us the wisdom and humility to navigate our differences with grace, and let us be united in Christ above all else.

JUSTICE AND RIGHTEOUSNESS

Pray that justice and righteousness will be at the heart of this election. We are called to seek justice and live out God's truth in the public square. Pray that the election process would reflect fairness, integrity, and accountability, and that leaders who pursue righteousness would be raised up.

"But let justice roll on like a river, righteousness like a never-failing stream!" -Amos 5:24

Prayer

Lord, we ask for your justice and righteousness to reign over our nation. We pray that those in power and those seeking office would uphold your standards of truth and fairness. May this election be free of corruption and injustice, and may your will be done.

PRAYING FOR LEADERS AND CANDIDATES

GODLY WISDOM FOR LEADERS

Pray that all candidates, whether running for local, state, or national office, would seek God's wisdom and direction. We know from Scripture that those who lead must be guided by godly principles to govern effectively. Pray for wisdom, courage, and discernment in their decisions and actions.

"The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, and knowledge of the Holy One is understanding." - Proverbs 9:10

Prayer

Father, we lift up the men and women running for office and ask that you fill them with your wisdom. Help them to seek your face in all things and to lead with integrity and righteousness. Surround them with godly counsel and strengthen their resolve to do what is right, even when it is difficult.

PROTECTION FOR LEADERS AND THEIR FAMILIES

PRAYING FOR THE CHURCH

UNITY IN THE BODY OF CHRIST

Pray that the Church would remain unified in the truth of scripture, even as political differences exist within the body. The enemy seeks to divide us, but we must remain steadfast in our unity under Christ. Pray that Christians would model humility, and a boldness to speak truth in love.

"That all of them may be one, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you." - John 17:21

Prayer

Jesus, we ask that your Church would stand united in this season. Help us to remember that our allegiance is first to your kingdom, and give us the grace to love and respect one another even when we disagree. Let our witness be a powerful testimony of your love to the world.

BOLDNESS TO PROCLAIM TRUTH

Pray that pastors and church leaders will be bold in speaking biblical truth from the pulpit. In times of moral and cultural confusion, the Church is called to be a pillar of truth. Pray for courage for leaders to preach kingdom values that transcend party lines and point people back to Christ.

"Preach the word; be prepared in season and out of season; correct, rebuke and encourage—with great patience and careful instruction." - 2 Timothy 4:2

Prayer

Lord, we pray for the leaders of your Church to stand firm in the truth. May they not be swayed by cultural pressures or fear of controversy, but boldly proclaim your Word with love and conviction. Give them courage to speak on issues that matter to your kingdom.

PRAYING FOR VOTERS

DISCERNMENT AND WISDOM FOR VOTERS

Prayer

TAKE ACTION

CALL TO CIVIC ENGAGEMENT

TAKE ACTION

KINGDOM VS. POLITICAL ALLEGIANCE

TAKE ACTION

PRAYING FOR KEY ISSUES

- **SANCTITY OF LIFE:** Pray for the protection of life, from the unborn to the elderly. Ask that voters and leaders prioritize life and that policies would reflect this. "For you created my inmost being; you knit me together in my mother's womb." (Psalm 139:13)
- **RELIGIOUS FREEDOM:** Pray that religious liberty would be upheld in our nation and that Christians would have the freedom to live out their faith without interference. "It is for freedom that Christ has set us free." (Galatians 5:1)
- PROTECTING THE FAMILY: Pray that the family unit, as designed by God, would be protected from policies and cultural shifts that undermine parental rights and redefine marriage and gender roles. Ask that lawmakers would pass legislation to support biblical definitions of family and to protect parents' rights in raising their children according to God's truth. "But as for me and my household, we will serve the Lord." (Joshua 24:15)

PRAYER AND FASTING

Leading up to the election, encourage believers to take part in a focused time of prayer and fasting. Fasting can deepen our reliance on God and heighten our awareness of His voice during important times.

 FASTING FOR THE ELECTION: Consider designating a specific day or week for a collective fast, where believers can focus on seeking God's guidance for the election. Provide instructions on different types of fasting and how to prepare spiritually.
